

Summer 2017 Human Rights Watch Internship Program Guidelines

Who: CMC freshmen, sophomores and juniors

All applicants must be in good standing with CMC and approved for off-campus study by the Dean of Student's (DOS) Office. The Center will request this approval from DOS prior to finalizing an applicant's internship award.

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Cover letter
 - a. Describe any relevant human rights experience you have (work or research based), your interest(s) in the field of human rights, and <u>your specific reasons</u> for wanting to intern at Human Rights Watch
- 3. Current résumé
- 4. Unofficial CMC transcript
- 5. Project budget
 - a. Show total expenses and sub-totals for travel (airfare, train, car, etc.), accommodations, food, and other expenses directly related to the internship including local ground travel (e.g., subway, rail pass).
- 6. Two letters of recommendation from CMC faculty members with whom the applicant has studied, covering, among other things, academic performance, ability to work effectively as a member of a team, integrity, reliability, maturity to work on projects/programs of a sensitive nature, ability to work effectively with little direct supervision, ability to stay on task and accomplish assignments on time.
- 7. Applications (2 copies) are due by 12:00 p.m. Monday, February 27th at the Center's office, Kravis 353. They should be directed to Kirsti Zitar, the Center's Assistant Director. Applications sent by e-mail attachment will not be accepted.

Upon completion of the summer internship, students are required to submit a written report detailing their experiences. This report is due on or before September 18, 2017.
