Limited drinks, snacks and other items will be available for purchase in the Butler Plaza prior to the Commencement Ceremony. The College requests that guests refrain from bringing pets to the ceremonies although assistive animals are permitted. Thank you for complying with this request.

Seating for both ceremonies is on a first-come, first-served basis. Seats may not be reserved but may be held if a family member remains at the seats. A member of the CMC staff will be at the ceremonies to provide assistance.

So that you do not have to leave your seat during the ceremonies, CMC has contracted for individual photos of each graduate receiving their hoods during the Hooding Ceremony and their diploma during the Commencement Ceremony. In addition, live streaming of the Commencement Ceremony will occur on May 14^{th} from 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. (PST). Please go to www.cmc.edu/commencement for additional details.
