### **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

## For The Claremont Colleges Health & Welfare Benefits

This is a summary of the annual report of the The Claremont Colleges Health & Welfare Benefits, EIN 95-4786748, Plan No. 522, for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Claremont University Consortium has committed itself to pay certain health and temporary disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

#### Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Anthem Blue Cross Life and Health Insurance Company, Gerber Life and Accident Insurance Company, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Safeguard Health Plans, Inc., A California Corporation, Standard Insurance Company, U.S. Behavioral Health Plan, California dba Optum and Zurich American Insurance Company to pay health, dental, vision, life insurance, long-term disability, prescription drug, business travel accident, employee assistance program and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2015 were \$30,586,991.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2015, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$557,885 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was (\$212,170).
