- issues



The applicant(s) must also include a plan for how knowledge and experience gained through proposed activities will benefit the greater College community.

Application Process:

One proposal submission per individual/group. Applications will be reviewed by the Women and Gender Leadership Fund Selection Committee and must include a detailed budget.
